THE COBB COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES \$30,000 IN CHARITABLE GRANTS

ATLANTA, April 1, 2020—**Cobb Community Foundation** (CCF) announced today that it is awarding \$30,000 in charitable grants from the **Cobb COVID-19 Community Response Fund**. The grants were made possible by Liberty Furniture, a CCF Diamond Level **Corporate Community Champion**, a program designed for corporations and local businesses who believe that good corporate citizenship involves supporting charitable endeavors that are impacting the community.

The three Cobb County non-profit agencies receiving \$10,000 each, include:

- **The Center for Family Resources** to support the organization's \$60K in 60 Days campaign, created to respond to the financial needs of families impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic,
- **Cobb Schools Foundation** to support access to digital learning devices for students in Osborne, Campbell, South Cobb and Pebblebrook High School clusters, and
- **Ser Familia, Inc.** to support emergency financial assistance for clients of Ser Familia's Smyrna office.

"The Cobb **Human Services Needs Assessment** we commissioned last year identified those areas of Cobb County with the greatest needs," stated **Shari Martin, President and CEO of Cobb Community Foundation**. "These grants will help families in those very communities who, in light of COVID-19, are facing challenges now that are truly unprecedented. We are so grateful to Liberty Furniture for allowing us to invest their charitable dollars where we know there will be a significant return."
